confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-8720. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: A WELL IN CROOKED RIVER BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 4.53 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (wells), together with that diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of appropriation described as follows:

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at time when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include air lines and pressure gauges or access ports for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the wells at all times.

The water user shall maintain weirs, meters or other suitable devices and shall keep a complete record of the amount of groundwater withdrawn.

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be subsequently reduced.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 2, 2000, at Special Order Volume 54, Page 309, approving Transfer Application 7739, and together with Certificate 76525, supercedes Certificate 68756, as modified by Transfer Application 7708, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 640.
