CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

U.S. UMPQUA NATIONAL FOREST

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-28741. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: ROW RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF COAST FORK WILLAMETTE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 19.1 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.15 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 4, 1963

The point of diversion is located as follows:

20 S	2 W	WM	31	SE NE	39	3280 FEET NORTH AND 210 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 31

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (CFS), or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use water is limited to the period when the flow of the Row River is more than 100 CFS at its mouth and the Coast Fork Willamette River is more than 135 CFS at its mouth, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


Water use measurement conditions:

- a. The water user shall maintain, in good working order, a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director at each point of diversion.
- b. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring devices; provided however, where the meter or measuring devices is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 29, 2010, at Special Order Volume 82, Page 1205, approving Transfer Application 11005, and together with Certificate 86678, supercedes Certificate 34613, State record of Water Right Certificates.
