confirms the right to store water perfected under the terms of Reservoir Application R-74893. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: RUNOFF, A TRIBUTARY OF ROCK CREEK, IN TWO UNNAMED RESERVOIRS

STORAGE FACILITIES: RESERVOIR 1 AND RESERVOIR 2

PURPOSE OR USE OF THE STORED WATER: MULTIPURPOSE USE

MAXIMUM VOLUME: 0.67 ACRE-FOOT (AF), BEING 0.43 AF IN RESERVOIR 1 AND 0.24 AF IN RESERVOIR 2

DATE OF PRIORITY: JANUARY 1, 1993

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, with a minimum diameter of 8 inches, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary for public safety or to satisfy prior downstream rights as determined by the Water Resources Director.


The right to store and use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
