 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LIDA MEE AND ANDERSON MEE
 APPLGATE, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of THOMPSON CREEK, a tributary of APPLGATE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 11.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1869 for 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs) for the IRRIGATION of 2.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC and STOCK USE; and 1872 for 0.18 cfs for the IRRIGATION of 9.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC and STOCK USE; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.22 cfs.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant (or if for other purposes, the place where water is put to beneficial use) is as follows:


