 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ANDERSON MEE AND LIDA MEE
 APPLGATE, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of DARNIEL AND RUCH GULCHES AND WASTE AND DRAINAGE WATER tributary of THOMPSON CREEK, a tributary of APPLGATE RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 45.66 ACRES and DOMESTIC.

This right was perfected under Permit S-4564. The date of priority is MARCH 23, 1920. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.66 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant (or if for other purposes, the place where the water is put to beneficial use) is as follows:


