confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-1271. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: A WELL

PURPOSE OR USE: STORAGE AND POND LEVEL MAINTENANCE FOR FISH, WILDLIFE, IRRIGATION, AND RECREATION

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, LIMITED TO 6.0 ACRE-FEET PER YEAR

DATE OF PRIORITY: FEBRUARY 11, 1959

The well is located as follows:

22 S	10 E	WM	30	NE SE	1260 FEET SOUTH AND 500 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 30

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation described as follows, and is limited to 6.0 AF per year, diverted at a rate not to exceed 0.02 cfs:

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director in good working order at the new point of appropriation.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where any meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The water user shall maintain in the pond a staff plate that is acceptable to the Watermaster, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device that measures the entire range and stage between empty and full in the reservoir.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION, PLACE OF USE, AND CHARACTER OF USE, approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 8, 2013, at Special Order Volume 89, Page 643, approving Transfer Application T-11463, and together with Certificate 88303, supersedes Certificate 33418, State record of Water Right Certificates.
