CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KURT BOWMAN

LA GRANDE OR 97850

confirms the right to use the waters of the GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary to the SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 57.82 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 373. The date of priority is 1883.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

2 S	38 E	WM	31	SW SW	ORODELL DITCH - 1858.33 FEET SOUTH AND 80.84 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 31

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.0 acre-feet per acre in any irrigation season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:

- a. The water user shall maintain a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director at the point of diversion.
- b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
- c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain the existing headgate and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.

The water user shall maintain and operate a fish screening and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in POINT OF DIVERSION, PLACE OF USE, AND PARTIAL CANCELLATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 27, 2012 at Special Order Volume 87, Page 1, approving Transfer Application T-11141, and together with Certificate 87408, supercedes Certificate 50172, State record of Water Right Certificates.
