CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ORODELL CANAL COMPANY

confirms the right to the use of waters of GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 5.0 ACRES under Permit S-5222 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the State Water Board of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 447, on the 15th day of November, 1922; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from AUGUST 26, 1921.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 8, 2006, at Special Order Volume 69, Page 602, approving Transfer Application T-7994, and supercedes Certificate 3810, State record of Water Right Certificates.
