## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ORODELL CANAL COMPANY 62876 MONROE LANE LA GRANDE OR 97850

confirms the right to use the waters of GRANDE RONDE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 49.4 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Engineer in Volume 8, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1901. The amount of water to which this right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre in any irrigation season, diverted at a rate not to exceed ONE-FORTIETH of a cubic foot per second per acre.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the genral supervision of the Department.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION and PARTIAL CANCELLATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 8, 2006, at Special Order Volume 69, Page 602, approving Transfer Application T-7994, and together with Certificate 82094, supercedes Certificate 6416, State record of Water Right Certificates.
