 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS a tributary of WOODS CREEK, tributary of the PUDDING RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 37.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5042. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 23, 1970. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.47 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.21 CFS FROM WELL NO. 1 AND 0.26 CFS FROM WELL NO. 2 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 44105, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUL 3 12017, approving Transfer Application T-12445.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
