CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

D. R. MORRISON  
KERBY, OR 97531

confirms the right to use the waters of JIMMY CREEK, a tributary of ILLINOIS RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 0.6 ACRE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 13, at Page 70. The date of priority is 1888. The amount of water to which this right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually used beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one cubic foot per second for each 50 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season of April 1 to November 1 of each year, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 13893, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered APR 05 2018, approving Transfer Application T-12495.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands of place of use herein described.
