CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That JAMES ESTES,

of Imaha, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Imaha River,
for the purpose of Irrigation, domestic and stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 11, at page 6; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1895

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three-eighths of
one cubic foot per second per acre of land irrigated, and not to exceed one and
one-half acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days during the irrigation
season.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

11.9 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
2.8 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
22.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 10;
4.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 11;
4.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 14;
15.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$,
17.4 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 15;
Township 3 South, Range 48 East, W. M.

And the said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
