Water use measurement conditions:

- a. The water user shall maintain the restrictors of measuring devices in good working order.
- b. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the restrictors or measuring devices; provided however, where the restrictors or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screens at the new points of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water users to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screens are functioning properly.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 11, 2013, at Special Order Volume 88, Page 1184, approving Transfer Application 11368, and together with Certificate 87856, supercedes Certificate 86184, State record of Water Right Certificates.
