CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of RIGHT FORK OF TALLOWBOX CREEK, a tributary of THOMPSON CREEK for IRRIGATION of 17 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1880. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.30 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
