## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DEBBIE L. THOMASON PO BOX 99 MERLIN OR 97532

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of SOUTH FORK ROCKY GULCH for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE IN AREA.

This right was perfected under Permit S-41107. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 15, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, (if lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as being within the NWNE, SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M., 800 FEET SOUTH AND 2250 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 35), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, in good working order at each point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening consistent with current Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) standards.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the

original point of diversion described as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in POINT OF DIVERSION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 8, 2010, at Special Order Volume 80, Page 570, approving Transfer Application 9468, and together with Certificate 86014, supersedes Certificate 80607, State record of Water Right Certificates.
