confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH MYRTLE CREEK, a tributary of MYRTLE CREEK for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 29.73 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-36512. The date of priority is APRIL 11, 1972. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes foresaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.37 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
