 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

H.A. BENDLER
 HOOD RIVER, OR 97031

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED DRAINAGE DRAW, a tributary of INDIAN CREEK for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 18.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-12173. The date of priority is MAY 9, 1936. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

2 N	10 E	WM	4	SE SE

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and also shall be limited to the water available at the point of diversion, provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate is issued to describe the right NOT modified by provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director, entered October 30, 2017, and recorded in Special Order Volume 107, Pages 46-56, approving a partial cancellation of the right evidenced by Certificate 19539 of the water right. This certificate supersedes Certificate 19539.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use herein described.
