CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That FRED W. FALCONER

of Pendleton, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed creek in Sec. 5, T. 1 N. R. 48 E. W. M., tributary of Imnaha River. for the purpose of Irrigation, domestic and stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 11, at page 6; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1902

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three-eighths of one cubic foot per second per acre of land irrigated, and not to exceed one and one-half acre feet per acre during any period of 50 days during the irrigation season.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.8 acre in SE 1/4 NE 1/4,
0.2 acre in NE 1/4 SE 1/4,
Section 5,
Township 1-North, Range 48 East, W.M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
