CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water of WELL 8 (Nofziger) in the FORT ROCK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 9.0 ACRES.

The right was perfected under Permit G-9126. The date of priority is JANUARY 13, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available from:

or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (wells), together with that diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:


When required by the Department the water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.

The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring devices at each point of appropriation. If the Director notifies the water user to install totalizing flow meters or other measuring devices, the water user shall install such devices specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 16, 2012, at Special Order Volume 87, Page 290, approving Transfer Application T-8420, and together with Certificate 87227, supercedes Certificate 83582, State record of Water Right Certificates.
