CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 0.6 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 16, at Page 523. The date of priority is 1903.

This right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original point of diversion, (BUNCH-SWINDEN DITCH), SWNE, SECTION 20, T 37 S, R 5 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

37 S	5 W	WM	20	NE NW	370 FEET NORTH AND 777 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, NENW, SECTION 20

The amount of water used for irrigation is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

37 S	5 W	WM	20	SW NW	1	1550 FEET SOUTH AND 180 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 20

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 12, 1991 at Special Order Volume 45, Page 495, approving Transfer Application T-6419, and together with Certificate 66905, supercedes Certificate 64422, State record of Water Right Certificates.
