 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

 GRANTS PASS OR 97527

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLGATE LAKE RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7810, a tributary of APPLGATE RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 0.6 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit S-46416. The date of priority is AUGUST 17, 1981.

This right is limited to not more than 1.28 ACRE-FEET STORED WATER ONLY, if available at the authorized point of diversion: APPLGATE DAM – S1/2, SE1/4, SECTION 25, T 40 S, R 4 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
37 S	5 W	WM	20	NE NW	370 FEET NORTH AND 777 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, NENW, SECTION 20

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract No. 1-07-10-W0287, or a satisfactory replacement, between the Bureau of Reclamation and the water user, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 12, 1991 at Special Order Volume 45, Page 495, approving Transfer Application T-6419, and together with Certificate 86131, supercedes Certificate 63299, State record of Water Right Certificates.
