CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WOODY AND MEGAN WOLFE 81544 HWY 82 WALLOWA, OR 97885

confirms the right to use the waters of the LOSTINE RIVER (AKA SOUTH FORK WALLOWA RIVER), a tributary to the WALLOWA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 78.6 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5 at Page 205. The date of priority is 1883 for 1.7 Acres and 1889 for 76.9 Acres.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.96 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (cfs), being 0.04 cfs under 1883 priority and 1.92 cfs under 1889 priority, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is further limited to an annual volume of 314.4 ACRE FEET (AF), being 6.8 AF under 1883 priority and 307.6 AF under 1889 priority, and shall not exceed 1.0 acre-foot per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31 of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season.
