CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WOODY AND MEGAN WOLFE
81544 HWY 82
WALLOWA, OR 97885

confirms the right to use the waters of the LOSTINE RIVER, a tributary to the WALLOWA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 10.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-12727. The date of priority is JULY 12, 1937. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.18 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31 of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot per acre for the remainder of the irrigation season from any and all sources. This right is further limited to an annual volume of 42.0 ACRE-FEET. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of Certificate 11899, State Record of Water Right Certificates, REDUCED IN RATE by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 8, 2018, approving Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-95. This Certificate, together with Certificate 93521 and a portion of Certificate 93535, supersedes Certificate 11899.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
