CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the LOSTINE RIVER (aka SOUTH FORK WALLOWA RIVER), a tributary to the WALLOWA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 33.6 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5 at Pages 200-202. The date of priority is MARCH 27, 1901.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.83 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is further limited to an annual volume of 134.4 ACRE FEET, and shall not exceed 1.0 acre-foot per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31 of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season, if available at the point of diversions, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water at the point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as:

WESTSIDE DITCH

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.


Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

This certificate describes that portion of Certificate 91012, State Record of Water Right Certificates, REDUCED IN RATE by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 8, 2018, approving Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-95. This Certificate, together with Certificate 93533 and a portion of Certificate 93535, supersedes Certificate 91012.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
