CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROBT M RUSSELL
VALE, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE WILLOW CREEK, a tributary to WILLOW CREEK for IRRIGATION, LIVESTOCK AND DOMESTIC of 73.3 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 426. The date of priority is 1906.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.84 CFS from February 15th to May 1st and 0.92 CFS from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation, the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 219.9 acre feet.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right Certificate 1614, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEB 06 2018, approving Transfer Application T-10589.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
