CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PAUL W. COOTS JR 6418 HOLLAND LOOP RD CAVE JUNCTION OR 97523

confirms the right to use the waters of SUCKER CREEK, a tributary to the EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 32.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK FOR TRACT 2.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 252, Volume 5, at Page 420, and Volume 5, at Page 397. The date of priority is 1865 FOR TRACT 2.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.64 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR TRACT 2, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, and that use of said water for irrigation purposes shall be confined to the irrigation season of April 1 to October 31 each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director in good working order at each point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife at the point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 23, 2010, at Special Order Volume 81, Page 239, approving Transfer Application 9781, and together with Certificate 86382, supersedes Certificate 79996, State record of Water Right Certificates.
