confirms the right to use the waters of HART LAKE, TRIBUTARY TO WARNER LAKES for IRRIGATION of 3194.72 ACRES and STOCK WATER.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 10, at Page 227. The date of priority is 1892.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed 20.8 cubic feet per second, and is further limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre of land irrigated prior to June 15<sup>th</sup>, and ONE-EIGHTIETH of a cubic foot per second per acre of land irrigated after June 15<sup>th</sup>, of each year, with a total limitation during each irrigation season of 3.0 acre-feet per acre.

The irrigation season is March 1<sup>st</sup> to October 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain and operate a fish screening and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

Water use measurement conditions:


- a. The water user shall maintain, in good working order, a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director at the point of diversion.
- b. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain a headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted as required by the Department.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 7, 2012, at Special Order Volume 87, Page 667, approving Transfer Application T-10750, and together with Certificate 85598, supercedes Certificate 9451, State record of Water Right Certificates.
