CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of COAST FORK WILLAMETTE RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for manufacturing (lumber mill).

This right was perfected under Permit S-23739. The date of priority is JULY 27, 1955. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.73 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR MANUFACTURING, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 26393, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEB 06 2018, approving Transfer Application T-12624.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
