## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICHARD KOCH 26951 S BARLOW RD CANBY OR 97013

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL, a tributary of PUDDING RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.8 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 4.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9715. The date of priority is OCTOBER 29, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.01 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.06 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
