confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-6268. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: A WELL IN UMATILLA RIVER BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: COMMERCIAL USE

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.37 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), LIMITED TO AN ANNUAL VOLUME OF 89.7 ACRE-
FEET, AND FURTHER LIMITED BASED ON THE ALLOCATION FOR SUBAREA "A" OF THE STAGE GULCH
CRITICAL GROUNDWATER AREA; THE RATE WILL BE PRORATED ACCORDINGLY

PERIOD OF USE: YEAR ROUND

DATE OF PRIORITY: DECEMBER 2, 1974

The well is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation, namely the basalt ground water source, and is restricted to the same subarea (A) of the Stage Gulch Critical Ground Water Area.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation and shall be limited to a total volume of 89.7 acre-feet, described as follows:

The water user shall maintain and operate an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted as required by the Department.

The water user shall allow the Department access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Department shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in POINT OF APPROPRIATION, PLACE OF USE, and CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 15, 2008, at Special Order Volume 76, Page 495, approving Transfer Application 10548, and together with Certificate 84626, supersedes Certificate 51220, State record of Water Right Certificates.
