## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BILLY L. COFFER 5600 NE MILL CREEK ROAD PRINEVILLE, OREGON 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of MILL CREEK, tributary to OCHOCO CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 30.7 ACRES, AND DOMESTIC, AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1868.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.38 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND and a reasonable amount for domestic and stock use, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

## STANTON DITCH

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-380-6010(6) to describe the water right for a non-completed change in an additional point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 25, 2015, at Special Order Volume 98, Page 389, approving Transfer Application 11135, and supersedes Certificate 83371, State record of Water Right Certificates.

# NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.
