CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of , for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values, and pollution abatement.

This right was perfected under Permit S-21641. The date of priority is July 25, 1952, *plus one minute*. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, further limited to an annual volume of 8.66 ACRE-FEET, or its equivalent in case of rotation from JUNE 1 THROUGH AUGUST 26.

The description of the point in which flows are to be maintained is the location of the previously authorized point of diversion under Certificate 26123, located approximately at:


At the specified point, the amount of water to which this right is entitled shall not exceed the quantity of water legally available at the original point of diversion. Stream channel losses and gains calculated based on available data and the use of water by senior appropriators will determine the amount of water to which this right is entitled downstream from the original point of diversion within the specified stream reach.

The instream right established by this transfer shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470 unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 26123, and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 107, Page 117, approving Conserved Water Application CW-100, and together with Certificate 93674 and the conserved water under CW-100, supersedes Certificate 26123, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
