CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED

MRS GERTRUDE WINNINGHAM
RT 1, BOX 18-A
JACKSONVILLE, OR 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of FOREST CREEK AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-22143, PERMIT R-859, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 12.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-17437. The date of priority is DECEMBER 18, 1946. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.31 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year, from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Application R-22143, Permit R-859, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right Certificate 20637, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered , approving Transfer Application T-12521.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
