CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of RHEA CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF WILLOW CREEK for IRRIGATION of 32.8 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 73. The dates of priority are 1874 for 17.8 ACRES and 1879 for 15.0 ACRES.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.296 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) AS OF PRIORITY DATE 1874 AND 0.25 CFS AS OF PRIORITY DATE 1879, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain and operate an approved fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- a. The water user shall maintain, in good working order, a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director at the new point of diversion.
- b. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in PLACE OF USE and POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 3, 2014, at Special Order Volume 92, Page 1013, approving Transfer Application T-11623, and together with Certificate 89367, supercedes Certificate 78513, State record of Water Right Certificates.
