## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-29072. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: UMPQUA RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF PACIFIC OCEAN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 27.4 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: AUGUST 27, 1963

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the UMPQUA RIVER is more than 525 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND AT TIDEWATER.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

a. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meters or measuring devices in good working order at each point of diversion.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

b. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upont reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen, as appropriate, at the points of diversion consistent with ODFW's operation and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 23, 2011, at Special Order Volume 85, Page 242, approving Transfer Application 11202, and supercedes Certificate 67627, State record of Water Right Certificates.
