CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILBER BROTHERS
77 W ADAMS
BURNS OR 97720

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE STINKINGWATER CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF MALHEUR RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 36.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-5358. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 11, 1922. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.45 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, in any combination, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
20 S	35 E	WM	25	NW SE	MIDDLE FORK MALHEUR DIVERSION - 640 FEET SOUTH AND 3850 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 25

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion together with that diverted at the original points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a totalizing flow meter or with prior approval from the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a headgate as required by the Department.

The water user shall maintain and operate a fish screen as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in POINTS OF DIVERSION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 11, 2010, at Special Order Volume 80, Page 261, approving Transfer Application T-10848, and supercedes Certificate 7665, State record of Water Right Certificates.
