 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

T.H. MILLER DBA DORATION FARMS
 RT 2 BOX 204
 NEWBERG, OR 97132

confirms the right to use the waters of the an UNNAMED STREAM, tributary to the WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 4.9 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 11.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-19463. The date of priority is MAY 29, 1950. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.21 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.06 CFS FOR PRIMARY IRRIGATION AND 0.15 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:


That part of the S1/2 NW1/4 SE1/4 and the SW1/4 SE1/4, lying between the County Road and the East Line of DLC #60 in Section 35, T3S, R2W, W.M.

This certificate is issued to describe the right modified by provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director, entered APR 05 2018, and recorded in Special Order Volume 107, Pages ~~1037-1038~~ approving a re-description and partial diminution of the right evidenced by Certificate 21762. This certificate supersedes Certificate 21762.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
