CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO
CITY OF COTTAGE GROVE
400 MAIN STREET
COTTAGE GROVE, OR 97424

confirms the right to use the waters of LAYNG CREEK , a tributary of ROW RIVER for MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM.

This right was perfected under Permit S-30. The date of priority is JUNE 12, 1909. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.67 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS).

The point of diversion is located as follows:


This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-380-6010 to describe the water right for a non-completed change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 21, 2008, at Special Order Volume 75, Page 391, and to describe the point of diversion as authorized under Transfer Application T-337, entered October 26, 1949 at Special Order Volume 6, Page 192, to correctly describe the name of the authorized source and together with Certificate 84168, supersedes Certificate 2385, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
