CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W. J. WELCH  
HAINES, OR 97833

confirms the right to use the waters of SEEPAGE AND WASTE WATER FROM ADJOINING LANDS, AND SPRINGS CAUSED THEREBY, a tributary of NORTH POWDER RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 352.5 ACRES AND STOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit S-6498. The date of priority is AUGUST 11, 1924. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.94 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


