 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the Walla Walla River, a tributary of the Columbia River for the purpose of IRRIGATION of 23.96 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 12, Page 9. The date of priority is 1880.

The use is limited to 1.5 miner's inches per acre, or 0.90 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and the right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the above described decree.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in the priority date described on Certificate 91620. This Certificate supersedes Certificate 91620, and describes the portion of water right Certificate 91510, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 7, 2016, approving Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-74, recorded in Special Order Volume 101, Pages 760-773. This certificate together with Certificates 91621 and 91464 supersedes Certificate 91510.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
