CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of PINE CREEK, a tributary of WALLA WALLA RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 8.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-19609. The date of priority is JULY 11, 1950. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.14 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

6 N	34 E	WM	21	SW NE	1530 FEET SOUTH AND 270 FEET EAST FROM THE N¼ CORNER OF SECTION 21

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 84152, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 18 2018, approving Transfer Application T-12312, and together with Certificate 93795, supersedes Certificate 84152, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
