CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 1 AND WELL 2 in the SILVIES RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 137.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11785. The date of priority is APRIL 1, 1991. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.87 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS); being 0.39 CFS from WELL 1 (Coleman and Frisbie), and 0.48 CFS from WELL 2 (Cox), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The period of allowed use is March 1 through October 31.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an airline and pressure gauge to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or other suitable measuring device in good working order, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month, and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the water user to report general water-use information, including the place and nature of the use of water under the right.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered, approving Transfer Application T-12565 for a change in point of appropriation and place of use.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
