CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FRED BENEDICT AND ANNA MANSFIELD
APPLEGATE, OR 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of HUMBUG CREEK, a tributary of the APPLEGATE RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 43.5 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1871.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.623 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 16427, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 07 2018, approving Transfer Application T-12683.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
