CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BENJAMIN F. ELLIS  
18285 NORTH APPLGATE RD  
GRANTS PASS, OR 97256

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLGATE LAKE RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7810, a tributary of the APPLGATE RIVER, for the SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 79.01 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit S-45939. The date of priority is JULY 22, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 50.0 ACRE-FEET, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract No. 1-07-10-W0318, or a satisfactory replacement, between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.


The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This certificate describes the portion of Certificate 62400 NOT modified by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 108, Page 623 approving a partial cancellation. This certificate supersedes Certificate 62400.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
