confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 73.

SOURCE OF WATER: WILLOW CREEK, TRIBUTARY TO THE COLUMBIA RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 40.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) AS OF PRIORITY DATE 1872 AND 0.58 CFS AS OF PRIORITY DATE 1905

PERIOD OF USE: MARCH 1 TO AUGUST 1 OF EACH YEAR

DATES OF PRIORITY: 1872 FOR 5.0 ACRES AND 1905 FOR 35.0 ACRES

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain, in good working order, a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director at each new point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter(s) or measuring device(s); provided however, where any meter(s) or measuring device(s) is/are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall operate and maintain an approved fish screen at the new point of diversion. If Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in POINT OF DIVERSION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director March 20, 2014, at Special Order Volume 91, Page 1021, approving Transfer Application T-11512, and supercedes Certificate 194, State record of Water Right Certificates.
