confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-35792. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: SCOGGINS RESERVOIR/HENRY HAGG LAKE, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-5777, A TRIBUTARY TO SCOGGINS CREEK

PURPOSE OR USE: MUNICIPAL USE

MAXIMUM VOLUME: 500.0 ACRE-FEET OF STORED WATER

PERIOD OF USE: DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON OF EACH YEAR

DATE OF PRIORITY: FEBRUARY 20, 1963

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NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director in good working order at the point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The use of water for the municipal use shall be limited to 500.0 acre-feet stored water only during the irrigation season of each year.


The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in PLACE OF USE and CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 17, 2015, at Special Order Volume 96, Page 249, approving Transfer Application 11872, supersedes Certificate 87303, State record of Water Right Certificates.
