CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the Little Walla Walla River, tributary to the Walla Walla River for IRRIGATION on 6.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12 at Page 9. The priority date is 1885.

The use is limited to 1.5 MINER'S INCHES PER ACRE, or 0.093 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

6 N	35 E	WM	35	NW NE	1960 FEET NORTH AND 210 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER ¼ CORNER OF SECTION 35

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of 1/40 of one cubic foot per second, or is equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and the right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the above-described decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in the location of the point of diversion described on Certificate 92517. This Certificate supersedes Certificate 92517, and describes the water right modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 5, 2017, and recorded in Special Order Volume 104, Page 547, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes Certificate 92517.
