confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-10397. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: A WELL IN MALHEUR LAKE BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 108.3 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 1.36 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: SEPTEMBER 29, 1983

The wells are located as follows:

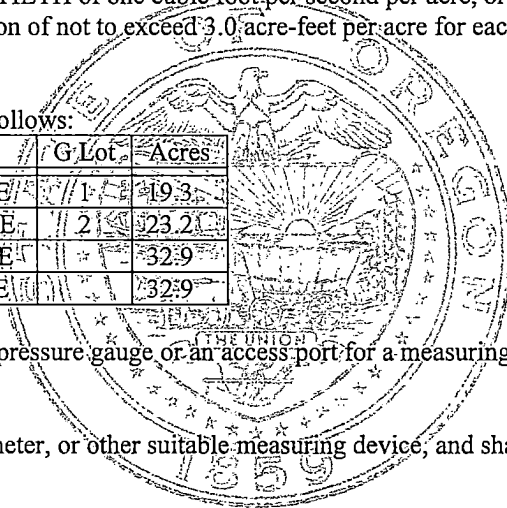
The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic-foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The works shall include an airline and pressure gauge or an access port for a measuring line, adequate to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times.

The water user shall maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.



NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director at each point of appropriation (new and existing) in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in POINTS OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 31, 2007, at Special Order Volume 103, Page 856, approving Transfer Application 12337, supersedes Certificate 82390, State record of Water Right Certificates.
