confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION of 18.19 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1868.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre.



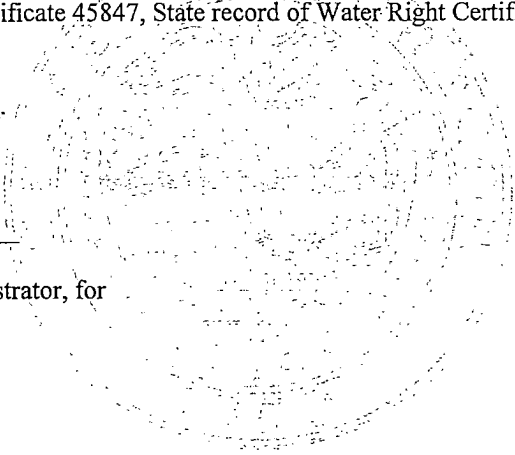

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 26, 1992, at Special Order Volume 46, Page 476, approving Transfer Application T-6186, and together with Certificate 67791, supercedes Certificate 45847, State record of Water Right Certificates.

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
