confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-37877. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: MCKENZIE RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF WILLAMETTE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATING 439.2 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 5.49 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: FEBRUARY 7, 1973

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season or each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device at each point of diversion. If the Director notifies the water user to install totalizing flow meter or other measuring device, the water user shall install such device specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device.

The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 68366 and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 9, 2010, at Special Order Volume 81, Page 846, approving Transfer Application T-10862, and together with Certificate 86578, supercedes Certificate 68366, State record of Water Right Certificates.
